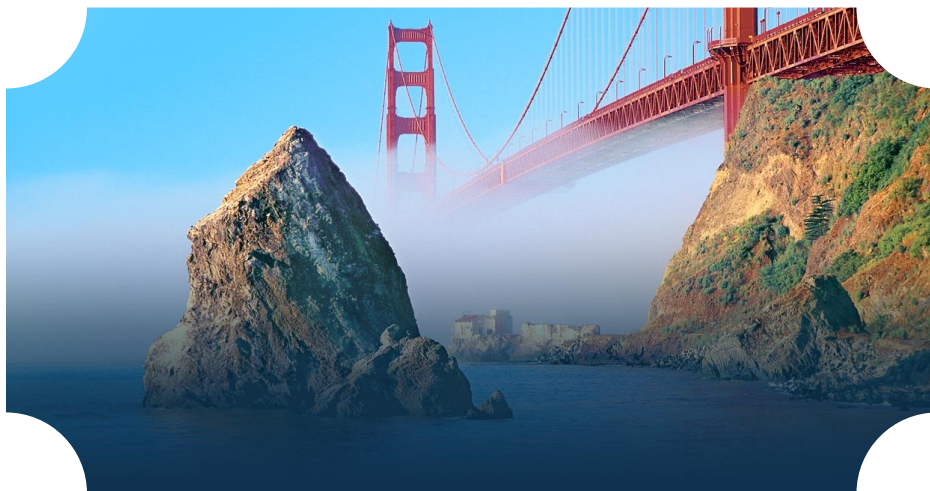

Saturday 18th March 2017 – Los Angeles

The Ruby Princess spent the day lying quietly alongside at Bert 93. At 16:17 with all crew and passengers on board, we were ready to sail. The mooring lines were let go at 16:34 and using thrusters, propulsion and rudders under the command of the Captain, together with the Bridge Team and the local Pilot the vessel was maneuvered into the channel. Once the stern was clear from the end of the pier the vessel was swung bow to port and proceeded ahead towards the breakwaters. Once clear of the channel, the local pilot disembarked at 17:22 and began our voyage towards our first port of call, San Francisco.

In the early morning we approached the pilot boarding area, the local pilot boarded from the port side at 05:04. Sailing into the port we passed under the famous Golden Gate Bridge at 05:49 and altered our course to starboard leaving Alcatraz Island on our port side. With the assistance of two harbour tugs and using the vessel's propulsion and six thrusters the Captain swung the bow and moved then laterally towards our berth. First Lines were sent ashore at 07:05 and we were all fast alongside Pier 27 at 07:22. Later that evening with all passengers and crew safely back onboard, we let go our lines at 23:04 sailing out of the harbour and passing under the bridge once again, and we disembarked the pilot at 00:15 and set southerly courses towards Santa Barbara.

Discover the irreplaceable personality of the City by the Bay

Built on 43 hills, effervescent San Francisco bursts at the seams with colorful history, superb restaurants, world-class shopping and fine museums. Add to that its romantic air and bold personality and you're in for an unforgettable adventure in San Francisco.

Living history

In 1776, a Spanish fort was established at the tip of the San Francisco Peninsula, the Presidio was the Spanish empire's northernmost military outpost and guarded California's harbor — but it wasn't until the Gold Rush of 1849 that San Francisco came to life.

San Francisco is truly one of a kind. Its eclectic neighborhoods and sparkling waterfront exude a modern flare, while traces of its illustrious past ribbons through the city giving it a timeless patina.

San Francisco grew rapidly during the Gold Rush when over 50,000 immigrants arrived to seek their fortune. Many were Chinese and you'll find the oldest Chinatown in North America here, complete with an authentic Dragon Gate, exotic attractions and over 300 traditional restaurants.

As you explore the many diverse districts, keep an eye out for the brightly painted Victorian row homes known as "Painted Ladies." Built between 1849 and 1915, they reflect a period of optimism and are one of the city's most photographed icons.

Before you know it you'll find yourself at the water's edge and heading Fisherman's Wharf. This landmark attraction was developed in the 1970s and boasts a cornucopia of activities with much of the action taking place on famed Pier 39. Wonderful restaurants offer fresh seafood along with captivating bay views.

A modern wonder of the world, the completion of the Golden Gate Bridge in 1937 symbolized the city's rebirth following the 1906 quake and fire. It's an awe-inspiring sight and the internationally recognized symbol of the city, and although visible from many vantage points, locals consider the prime viewing area to be Twin Peaks. The sweeping views from an elevation of 922-feet make for dramatic images.

Lush and verdant, Golden Gate Park was conceived in the late 1800s. Spreading over 1,000 acres, it is the centerpiece of the city, home to the Conservatory of Flowers, the De Young Museum, California Academy of Sciences and the magnificent Japanese Tea Garden.

Beauty beyond

Leave the city behind and witness the natural splendor of the Bay Area. Sausalito, a small waterfront town, offers spectacular views, art galleries, petite cafes and charming walking streets. This wonderful area was named by Spanish explorers for the "little willow" trees found along the banks of its streams. Continue on through the Mill Valley region to the redwood forests of Marin Woods, named for famed naturalist John Muir. The coastal redwoods are some of the tallest living things in the world, the highest towers 252 feet in the air. Most of the trees you will see are 600 years old or even older. Woods cannot do this awe-inspiring sight justice so bring your camera for a photo study of this magnificent National Park.

From Pier 38 at Fisherman's Wharf, also known as Alcatraz Landing, you can hop on a ferry and cross the Bay to "The Rock." The infamous prison closed in 1963, but you can make history yourself by entering the cells once inhabited by the "Bird Man" and notorious mobster Al Capone.

Sip and Savor

The rustic Sonoma Valley, less than an hour outside of San Francisco, has earned an international reputation as one of California's top viticultural areas. Sonoma is home to more than 40 premium wineries, all quite close to each other along an enchanting stretch of country roads.

Wine tasting excursions to the area travel across the Golden Gate Bridge to the Carmelo District and the picturesque town of Sonoma. You'll embark on a wine-tasting tour at select vineyards that range from major producers to boutique labels.

At every turn, you'll encounter historic landmarks, modern wonders and breathtaking vistas. It's no wonder that freespined San Francisco, with its easy sophistication and timeless charm, is one of the most beloved cities in the world.

DID YOU KNOW?

Local cuisine

San Francisco boasts a wide variety of places to eat, appealing to different kinds of palates. Fisherman's Wharf is famous for its Italian seafood restaurants with waterfront views. Pier 39, located at Beach Street and the Embarcadero, offers two levels of waterfront restaurants. Vendors along Jefferson Street sell Dungeness crab from steaming cauldrons and walk away seafood cocktails. And don't leave town without trying the clam chowder in a sourdough bread bowl, a signature San Francisco dish.

Paint cycle

The Golden Gate Bridge doesn't come by its orange color easily. By the time the paint crew gets from one end to the other — it's time to start the whole project again!

The Rock

On March 21, 1963, Attorney General Robert F. Kennedy ordered Alcatraz Federal Prison to release its last inmates. Over 29 years there were 14 attempts by 36 prisoners, but there are no documented successful escapes from Alcatraz.

Blue jeans

San Francisco is the birthplace of denim jeans. They were invented during the Gold Rush for miners who needed comfortable, strong pants. Chances are you're wearing a pair right now!

All aboard!

At 4 o'clock in the morning on August 2nd, 1873, Andrea Smith Halliday tested the first cable car on Clay Street in San Francisco. Every July in Union Square, a traditional "ball ringer" contest is held to commemorate this unique and historic mode of transportation.

Cable car etiquette

If you plan on boarding a cable car, here are a few tips to keep you on track. Wait on the sidewalk and wave to the gripman to stop. You can enter from either side of the car. If it's crowded, look for the "hang on" poles provided and do just that!

"Summer of Love"

Step back in time to 1967 when you visit the Haight-Ashbury district. San Francisco was hugely popular with the "Hippie Movement" and this intersection is sacred ground for those who want to experience bohemian ambience.

The Streets of San Francisco

San Francisco's varied scenery and striking urban landscape is why filmmakers flock to the area. This 1970s television police drama was actually filmed on location in San Francisco and starred Paul Mallon and Michael Douglas as police detectives. From Hitchcock's classic *North by Northwest* (starring James Stewart & Kim Novak) to the city-wide chase scene in *Bullitt* (Steve McQueen) to the modern thriller *Beats per Minute* (Chace Dune and Michael Dougan) San Francisco is always ready for its close-up!

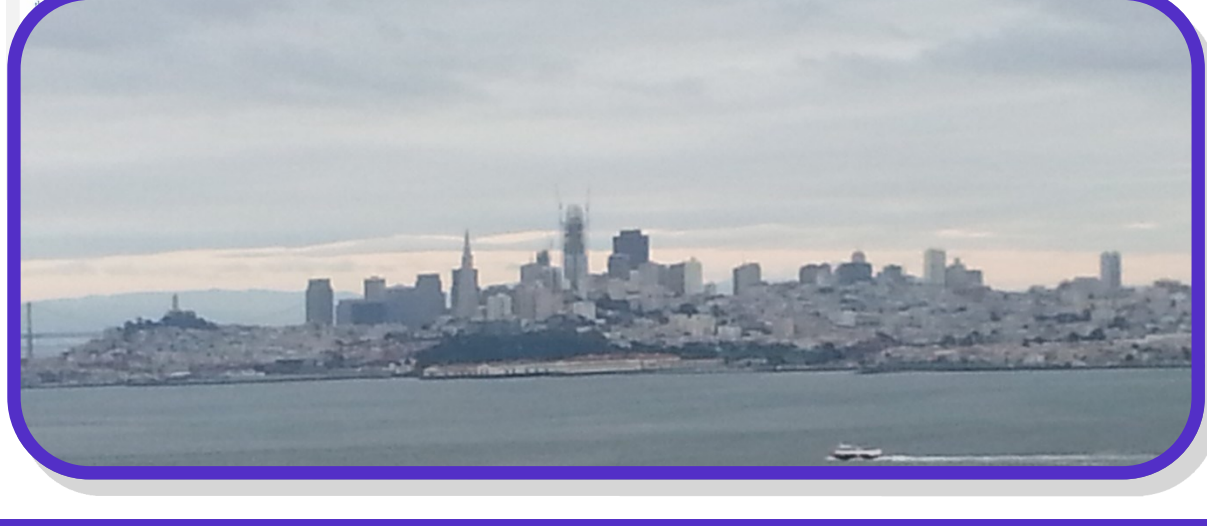

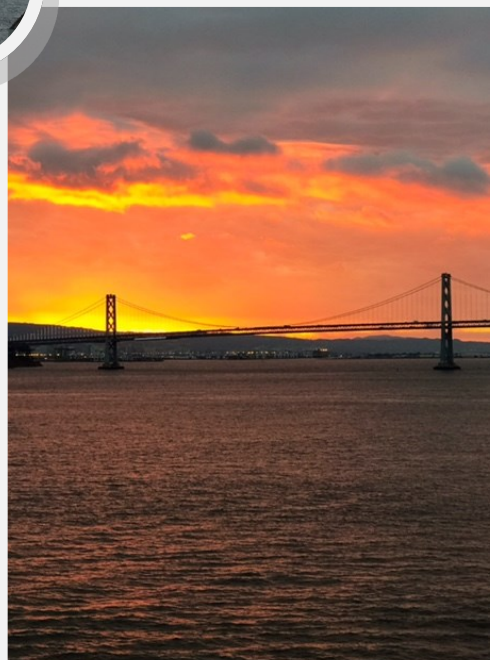

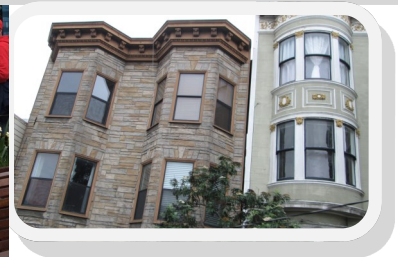
During the 29 years it was in use, the jail held some of the most notorious criminals in American history,[6] such as Al Capone, Robert Franklin Stroud (the "Birdman of Alcatraz"), George "Machine Gun" Kelly, Bumpy Johnson, Rafael Cancel Miranda (a member of the Puerto Rican Nationalist Party who attacked the United States Capitol building in 1954),[25] Mickey Cohen, Arthur R. "Doc" Barker, James "Whitey" Bulger, and Alvin "Creepy" Karpis (who served more time at Alcatraz than any other inmate). It also provided housing for the Bureau of Prisons staff and their families. During its 29 years of operation, the penitentiary claimed that no prisoner successfully escaped. A total of 36 prisoners made 14 escape attempts, two men trying twice; 23 were alive, six were shot and killed during their escape, two drowned, and five are listed as "missing and presumed drowned".

[26] The most violent occurred on May 2, 1946, when a failed escape attempt by six prisoners led to the Battle of Alcatraz.

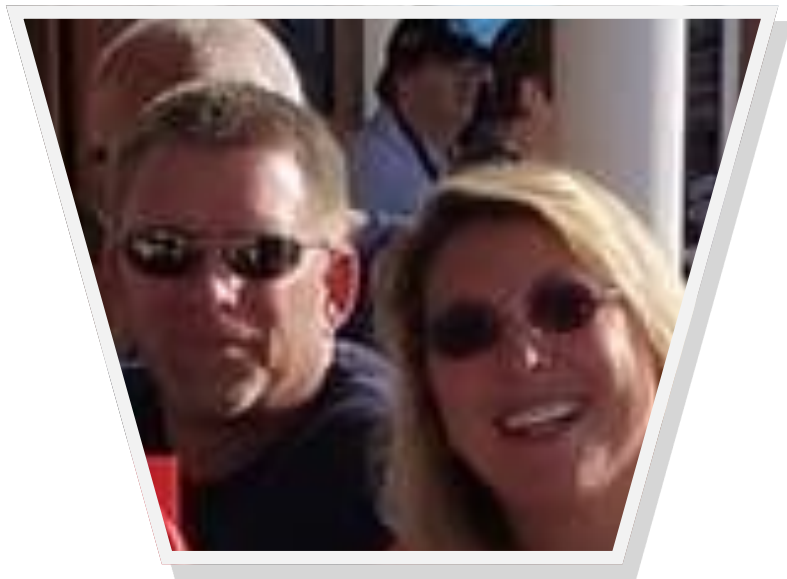

DID YOU KNOW?

Local cuisine
Sustainable, fresh seafood like sea bass, crab and lobster can be found on most menus, as well as chicken and beef from local ranchers, artisanal cheeses and chocolates. A wide array of international cuisines are served including dishes that celebrate the city's Latin heritage so if you're hungry for a taco, quesadilla or sopa, there are plenty of authentic "taquerias" to quell your appetite.

Historic founding
For a look at one of Spain's original military outposts, visit El Presidio. Established in 1782, the Santa Barbara Royal Presidio was the last in a chain of four military fortresses built by the Spanish along the coast of California. Here, you'll find the city's oldest remaining building, built in 1786, which now provides housing for married soldiers and their families. The grounds include an adobe chapel, a two-story lookout tower, and soldiers' and commander's quarters.

Lighty mission
Visitors can still reside at the venerable Santa Barbara Mission. The sandstone Roman facade and adobe walls demonstrate the missionaries' integrated European architecture with materials found on the California frontier – mud, stone, and timber.

Natural wonders
The 100-year-old Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History displays over three million artifacts and specimens including a 72-foot blue whale skeleton, animal dioramas, insects, a "fossil bounce", and planetarium.

In tribute
To honor the explorer who first sailed into the channel, the portion of California State Route 1 Highway that runs from the town of Los Carpines north to San Francisco is called the Cabrillo Highway.

Horsing around
In addition to wineries, Santa Ynez Valley is famous for ranches that raise Arabian, Andalusian, Paint, and Icelandic horses.

In the movies
Santa Barbara was California's first movie capital. In 1910, the American Film Company opened Flying A Studios on the corner of State and Mission Streets. At the time, it was the largest studio of its kind in the world. Before it closed its doors in 1920 it produced over 1,200 movies.

Nature in the city
Santa Barbara is home to more open space per capita than any other city in the country. 53 parks throughout the city offer the perfect location for picnics, play or simple relaxation.

Waterfront landmark
At 130 years old, Stearns Wharf is one of California's oldest and most beautiful wharfs. Built primarily of wood, the wharf has withstood waves, fires, and earthquakes.

Crude beginnings
Oil was discovered in the Santa Barbara area just before 1900, the world's first offshore oil drilling development soon sprouted up and still active today.

Green peace
Santa Barbara is home to 24,000 public trees.

America's Riviera

White washed houses dripping with bougainvillea, sapphire-blue water rolling up a rocky coast, palm-lined beaches, and an enviable climate. No, it's not the French or Italian Riviera its Santa Barbara, a quiet little town that's big on jaw-dropping scenery, Spanish and Moorish style buildings, and unforgettable experiences.

Wine and windmills
Just outside of Santa Barbara is the Santa Ynez Valley, home to some of California's most accomplished winemakers. In picture postcard scenery of verdant hillsides and acres of sun-soaked vineyards is the perfect setting for a number of wine tasting adventures.

Savor a full day of winery-hopping in lovely locales reminiscent of those in the Provençal French countryside. Not only will you have the opportunity to indulge in excellent vintages but you can learn about the process of winemaking in a fun and informative environment.

Nestled between the mountains and ocean is the quaint Danish-themed town of Solvang. Founded in 1911 by Danes who wanted to leave harsh Midwestern winters behind, Solvang offers everything from wooden shoes to Danish pastries. Enjoy a stroll along cobblestone sidewalks past buildings that feature half-timbered walls and simulated thatched roofs that pay homage to Danish architecture. Upon further exploration you'll even encounter a replica of the famous Little Mermaid statue from Copenhagen as well as a bust of famed Danish fable writer Hans Christian Andersen.

Seafaring creatures great and small
Tucked on California's southern-facing coast and sheltered behind Channel Islands National Park, the waters off Santa Barbara make an ideal corridor for whale migration, with 30 different species of whales swimming through the Pacific Ocean at any given time of the year.

Pacific gray whales make an appearance between December and May while blue whales, fin whales and humpbacks cruise through from June through September. And at any time of year you can witness dolphins, porpoises, sea lions, sea otters and elephant seals frolicking in the waters.

Experience a thrilling whale-watching expedition aboard a state-of-the-art catamaran. Cruise along the Channel Islands, sometimes called the Galapagos of North America, and watch for magnificent whales that spout and breach from a luxuriously appointed cabin with both seating and large tinted windows that offer excellent viewing. This amazing adventure ends back on land with a visit to Channel Island Cove State Historic Park, site of some of the finest remaining rock art created by the Chumash dating back to the 1600s.


As you discover Santa Barbara's abundant charms, its unique architecture, historical missions, hill-hugging homes, and world-renowned wineries you'll discover what makes Santa Barbara a premier resort destination.

A colorful history
An abundance of fish in the Pacific Ocean's crystalline waters drew the Chumash tribe to this idyllic area 8,000 years ago. In 1542, two sailing vessels under the command of Portuguese explorer Juan Cabrillo sailed through the channel en route from Mexico followed by Sir Francis Drake in 1579. In 1602, the Spanish conquistador Sebastian Vizcaino named the region but it would be 167 years before Spain returned.

Santa Barbara's Spanish history begins with the founding of the majestic Santa Barbara Mission in 1786, the tenth of 21 Franciscan missions in California. Set against a backdrop of rugged mountains, the mission's commanding presence and graceful lines leave no doubt as to why she is called "Queen of the Missions." The history of the area reveals itself in the mission's museum, chapel and historic cemetery where many of the city's founders are interred.

The Spanish ruled the area until 1822, when Mexico asserted its independence and California became a Mexican territory. The end of the Mexican period came quickly when Santa Barbara formally became part of the United States in 1847.

A 1925 earthquake leveled the town, and civic leaders rebuilt in the Spanish colonial style that now unifies the city.

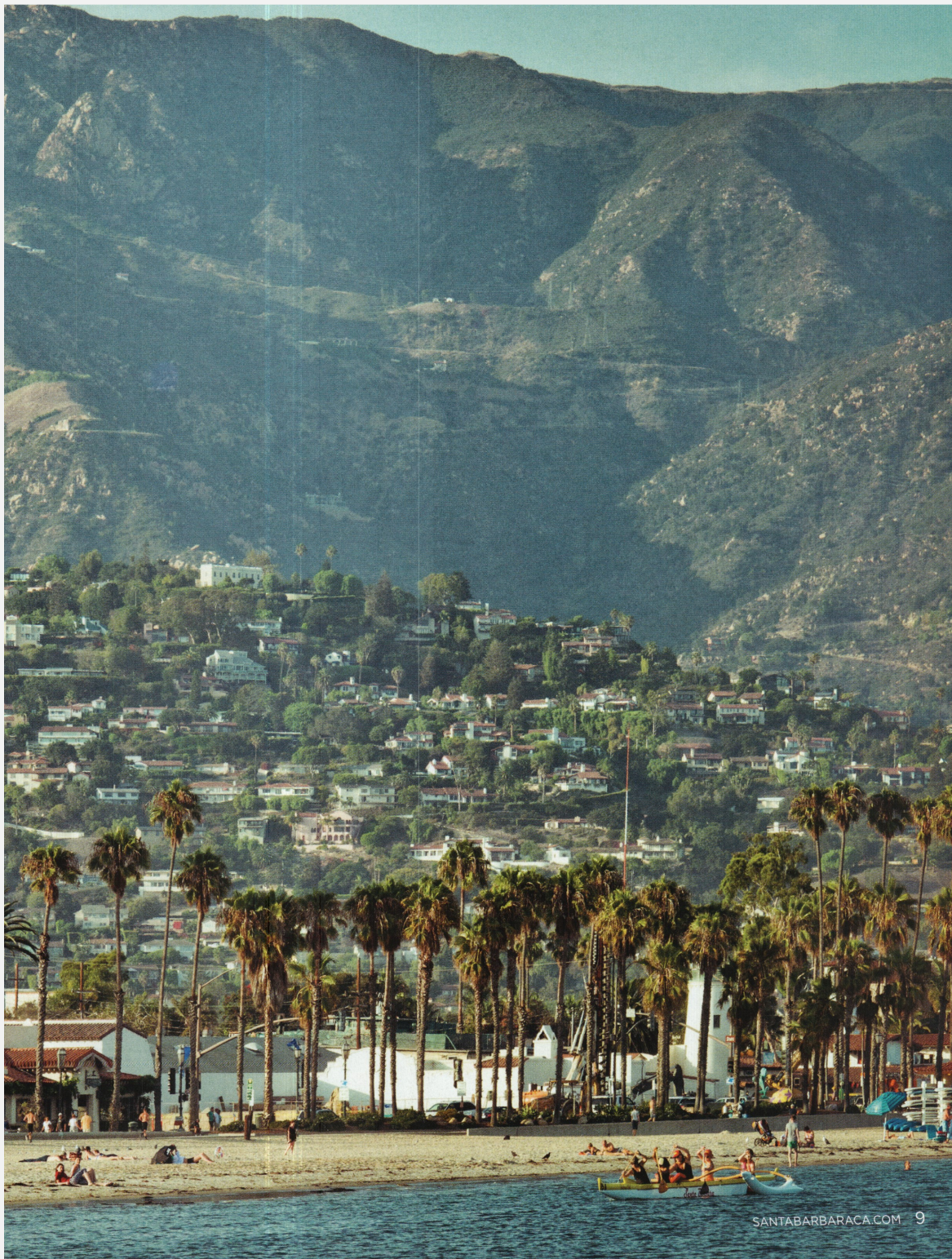

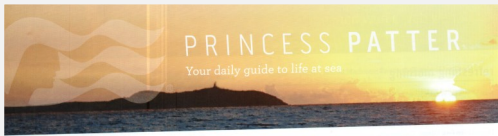

Thursday 23rd March 2017 – San Diego

Since departure from Santa Barbara, Ruby Princess all night long set south easterly courses leaving Catalina Island on our portside. Once arrived on the Pilot station at 06:30, we boarded the local pilot and sailed into the buoyed channel to our berth where we were all fast with gangways rigged and ready at 08:06. Once all passengers and crew safely back onboard we let go our lines at 17:06. Once the stern was clear from the end of the pier the vessel was swung bow to port and proceeded ahead out of the harbour. Once clear of the buoyed channel, we disembarked the local pilot at 17:48 and set various southerly courses towards Ensenada.

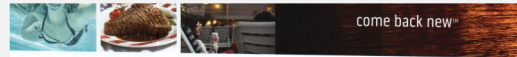

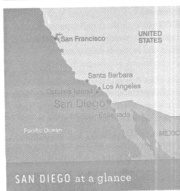

Where the living is easy

With its endless sunshine, pristine beaches and glistening blue Pacific waters it's easy to see why San Diego's laid-back charms have earned it nicknames such as "America's finest city" and "Sandy Ego." And the city does more than live up to its reputation—legendary attractions like the San Diego Zoo, Sea World and Old Town will keep you busy, entertained and captivated.

The birthplace of California

The San Diego area was home to the Kumeyaay Indians for 10,000 years before explorer Juan Rodriguez Cabrillo sailed into San Diego Bay in 1542. But it would take another 200 years before the Spanish Crown returned.

Missionaries, soldiers and settlers arrived in 1769 and built California's first mission on Presidio Hill, known today as Old Town. After Mexico won its independence from Spain in 1821 the tiny settlement was granted pueblo status. Following the American-Mexican war, California became a state and San Diego became a city in 1850.

Soak up the city sights

For a look at the birthplace of San Diego hop aboard the Old Town Trolley and learn how the city transformed from a Mexican pueblo to an American settlement. Your trip through yesterday also includes the historic Gaslamp Quarter, known for its Victorian and Art Deco architecture, and a visit to Coronado Island, once the playground of politicians, playboys and movie stars.

Coast tours of the city not only journey through Old Town but also include the stunning seaside village of La Jolla, considered the "Jewel of Southern California." Boasting some of California's most gorgeous and majestic coastline, this affluent, hilly seaside resort community features boutique-lined streets, fine restaurants, and art galleries.

If Old Town exemplifies the Spanish and Mexican birth of San Diego then Balboa Park can certainly claim its American roots. Dating back to 1868, the 1,400-acre park ranks as the nation's largest urban cultural park. Enjoy a self-guided tour of its stunning gardens, stroll the graceful promenades, and visit the engaging Spanish Colonial-designed museums.

See San Diego from a dolphin's point of view with a cruise across the sparkling waters of the Pacific. Glide past historic vessels including the Star of India, marvel at the majesty of massive naval aircraft carriers and a navy submarine base. Take in the windswept beauty of the Old Point Loma Lighthouse, which has been safely guiding mariners into the harbor since 1855 and be on the lookout for sea lions and dolphins.

Where the wild things are

Spend the day monkeying around in the 100-year-old San Diego Zoo, a tropical oasis that's home to 4,000 rare and endangered animals, and over 700,000 exotic plants. Thrill to the sight of a menagerie of gorillas, tigers, giant pandas, flamingos, mandrills, polar bears, giant tortoises, and leopards during animal encounters, interactive experiences, and keeper presentations. Experience the adventure of an African safari at the San Diego Zoo Safari Park. Witness the spectacle of animals roaming freely in surroundings similar to their natural habitats and come face-to-face with many of the rare and exotic animals that make the park their home. Though you won't be allowed to pet a lion, you can hand-feed colorful rainbow lorikeets, stroke gentle deer and antelope, and catch the breathtaking sight of birds in flight.



Hotel del Coronado

For animals that like to play in the water be sure to check out Sea World Adventure Park, a 189-acre facility dedicated to the life-giving oceans of our beautiful blue planet and home to over 10,000 animals, including 16 species of marine mammals, more than 430 species of fishes and over 100 species of birds! Watch sharks as they swim all around you and see beluga whales, polar bears and walrus. Be amused by the wedding charm of penguins and amazed by the vibrant colors of tropical and fresh water fish as they move with the graceful motion of currents in the park's three massive aquariums.

Part sun-drenched Mediterranean landscape, part south-of-the-border zest and part quintessential California beach town, you will find San Diego's laid-back charms and charisma so appealing.

Avocado aficionado

The town of Palmdale, located in Northern San Diego County, is the avocado capital of the world.

Cruising

Each year, over 200 cruise ships berth in San Diego Harbor.

Lindbergh's connection

San Diego was both the birthplace and the first flight departure point for Charles Lindbergh's revolutionary plane, the Spirit of St. Louis. He took off from San Diego in 1927, headed for New York, and then non-stop to Paris and back home.

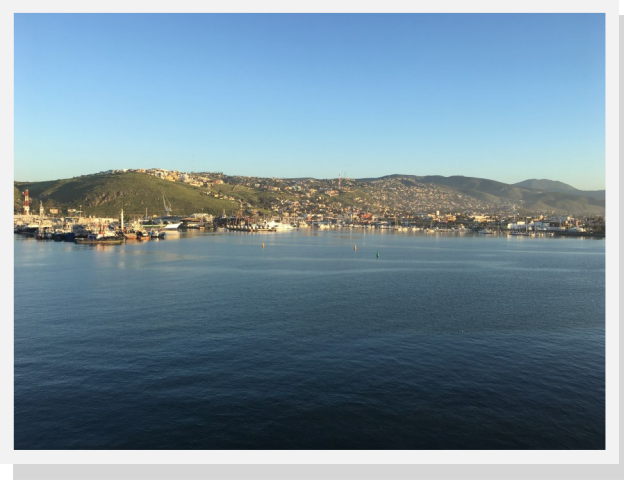

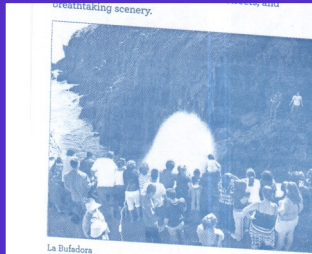

La Bufadora

A port by any other name

20 years after the Spanish conquest of the Aztecs by Spanish conqueror Hernán Cortés, Portuguese explorer Juan Rodríguez Cabrillo discovered this small bay in 1542 and named it San Mateo. Sixty years later, the Spanish explorer Sebastián Vizcaino arrived, took one look at his stunning surroundings and renamed it Ensenada de Todos Los Santos, "inlet of all the saints." However, the area remained unexplored and unsettled until the 19th century.

After the loss of the Mexican town of San Francisco and San Diego during the 1848 war with the U.S., Ensenada became the most important seaport in northern Mexico. Then, the discovery of gold in nearby Real del Castillo lured many American prospectors here. Even more Americans came during Prohibition looking for legal libations. Plush resorts and gambling casinos, like the Riviera del Pacifico, were built to accommodate their lavish lifestyles and wealth. Now nicknamed "Cinderella of the Pacific," this beautiful city on the bay has transformed into one of Mexico's most popular destinations.

... permit wines to the Spanish crown put a halt to the agricultural endeavor. But this didn't stop Catholic missionaries from establishing vineyards and producing wines around Baja. Today, more than 90% of Mexico's wines are produced in Ensenada and its surrounding regions.

Three wineries offer tours and tastings that showcase a wide variety of wines such as chardonnay, chenin blanc, sauvignon blanc, cabernet, syrah, merlot and cabernet franc. In downtown Ensenada, you'll find the tasting room of the 124-year-old Bodegas de Santo Tomas winery. As Mexico's oldest, it still uses the grape varieties planted by Jesuit missionaries in the 18th century. Nestled in the beautiful valleys surrounding Doña Lupe, which produces organically grown grapes. Here, you'll see the entire production process, from the crushing of grapes and fermentation, to the pressing, aging and bottling.

Discover Ensenada's natural wonders

The natural beauty of the area's famous beaches is one source of Ensenada residents' pride. Estero Beach and Playa El Faro offer a quiet escape while San Miguel is a great surfing spot. If you'd like to see one of the world's largest blowholes, be sure to visit the scenic peninsula of Punta Banda, home to the spectacular La Bufadora. Located just 17 miles from Ensenada, "the snorter" is a small inlet carved out of the rocks. When seawater crashes into the tiny crevasse, you'll hear a loud roar as 100 feet of water is forced through a narrow opening. When and if you time it just right, you may see water explode as high as 100 feet. Legend describes this natural phenomenon as the angry snorts of a whale that got stuck inside the underwater cave and is trying to get out.

With its soothing Mediterranean-type temperatures and refreshing cool ocean breezes, Ensenada offers an escape from the everyday. The vineyards, beaches, history, food and culture are just a few of the reasons why you'll want to visit this fabled location time and time again.

Shore Excursions: Passengers will meet at a specific location for each shore excursion departure. Please refer to your ticket and the Princess Pass for the correct place and time. Your Shore Excursion staff or our Tour Operator will be at that location to assist you. It's recommended that you drink bottled water while in port.

Docking: Your Princess ship will dock at the Ensenada Cruise Port Village.

Proper Attire: The weather is consistently mild and pleasant. A light shirt, shorts and a long skirted for the occasional cool evening.

Transportation: It is an approximate 15 to 20 minute walk to town or passengers can take a shuttle for transportation into town. The cost of the shuttle is \$3 USD roundtrip. La Bufadora is a marine geyser or blowhole located on the Punta Banda Peninsula in Baja California, Mexico. The spout of sea water is the result of air, trapped in a sea cave, exploding upwards. Air is forced into the cave by wave action and is released when the water recedes. This interaction not only creates the spout, but a thunderous noise as well. The phenomena repeats every minute or so with its volume depending on the strength of the waves. [1] La Bufadora is one of the largest blowholes in North America, often shooting upwards more than 30 metres (100 ft) above sea level. The exhibit hall roof top is approximately 24 metres (80 ft) above sea level and the blowhole frequently sprays above

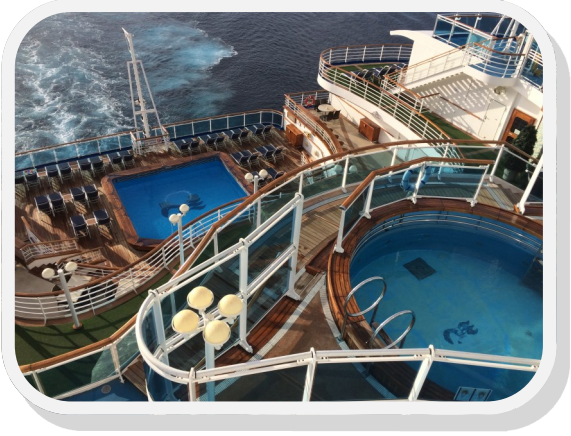


